Matters raised by members of the public:** A member of the public conveyed a thank you to the Clerk from the Skerne and Wansford Jubilee Committee for her help in securing a grant from the East Riding of Yorkshire's Queen's Platinum Jubilee Fund. Additionally, they raised their concern about the ineffective community consultation carried out by the Skerne and Wansford parish councillors in regards to the Harmony Energy Community Fund. Councillors expressed their frustration that despite their best efforts to encourage community involvement that there had been little response to date. The Clerk reported that it had been included in several newsletters, posters had been put up around the villages and information posted on the villages Facebook page. Councillors agreed that further consideration would need to be given to a community consultation event. Suggestions for how the fund could be used were raised by a member of the public and included the installation of a pavement in Skerne, running water for St Leonards church in Skerne and a maintenance person for the villages.
